Adjustment for HEALTH CARE COSTS

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education include in the final budget the adjustment for increased costs of health benefits in the amount of \$19,944. The additional funds will be used to pay for the additional increases in health benefit premiums and the use of Bank Cap in the amount of \$117,423.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, a board of education must establish a maximum dollar limit for travel expenditure, as defined in N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.1 et seq.,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the tentative budget a maximum travel expenditure in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the 2024-2025 school year. The maximum travel expenditure amount for the 2023-24 school year is \$5,000.00, of which, \$2,562.00 has been spent and \$00.00 is encumbered to date.

The Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district;
