5. **APPROVAL OF THE 2026-27 BUDGET**

Resolution to adopt the Island Heights Elementary School District Final Budget for the 2026-2027 school year as follows:

General Revenue	\$3,316,157
Special Revenue Fund Revenues	\$534,267
Debt Service Fund Revenues	\$190,844
General Fund Tax Levy	\$2,794,657
Debt Service Fund Tax Levy	\$125,954

BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Education includes in the final budget the adjustment for increased cost of health benefits in the amount of \$98,000. The additional funds will be used to pay for additional increases in health benefit premiums.

Supporting documentation on this budget also contains an itemization of certain expenditures required under administrative regulations.
